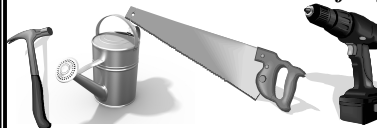

PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

Points from the Parish Council Meeting 1st March 2011

Police Report January 2011

There were 5 recorded crimes in Wrawby in January 2011 - 1 burglary, 1 theft, 1 possession of controlled drugs and 2 thefts from vehicles. This higher than usual number of crimes once again highlights the need for residents to remain vigilant. The total recorded crimes for the whole of 2010 was 15, which compared favourably with other villages in the area. Council has also received details of the Police Neighbourhood Action Team meeting in January in which wildlife crime (hare coursing etc.) was discussed at length, with the Police stressing their determination to confront this type of crime (with some success) - again farmers, landowners etc. are asked to remain vigilant.

Census

Once again, North Lincs Council has stressed to council the need for all residents to correctly complete the 2011 census forms (census on 27th March 2011) which will be received shortly. If just 3% of the local population aren't counted in the census, as much as £24m of lost funding from central government will accrue over the next 10 years. Please ensure therefore that the census forms are fully completed

Parish Council Elections

Some local elections will be held on Thursday 5th May. In addition to some North Lincolnshire Councillors, ten Wrawby Parish Councillors will also be elected on that date. Application and nomination papers are available from the Clerk to the Parish Council – Graham Foster tel 651250. Candidates must be 18 years or older and a Commonwealth or EU Citizen and have been resident or worked in Wrawby or within 3 miles of Wrawby. The completed nomination forms **MUST** be delivered to Pittwood House, Scunthorpe, not later than noon on Monday 4th April. A Parish Council election will only be necessary if there are more than 10 candidates.

WRAWBY MILL OPEN DAY AND EASTER EGG HUNT

On Easter Monday, 25th April, there will be an Open Day at the mill and Easter Egg Hunt for children. It will be open between 2pm and 5pm. Adults £2. Children £1 and a Family Ticket is £5.

There will be clues placed around the ground floor and around the outside of the mill and children will get a free egg when they solve the clues. We hope that lots of villagers will come to the mill that day and on the other Open Days (the next is one week later on Monday 2nd May.)

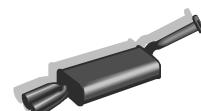
