## **PARISH COUNCIL NEWS**

### **Notes from Parish Council Meeting 3rd December**

#### **Play Area Seating**

N Lincs Council have confirmed that a refurbishment of Brigg town centre is planned for next year and some existing seats/furniture may be available to be used in Wrawby. This will be followed up.

#### **Mobile Fish and Chip Shop**

The Council Chairman has received a request from a mobile fish and chip shop proprietor to visit Wrawby for a 2 hour period on either a Wednesday or a Friday evening. However no suitable site has yet been found and N Lincs Council are to confirm licence, hygiene, planning, highways details before a final decision is made. #### **Leisure Centre**

Residents will be aware that the Swimming Pool was closed for remedial work – it re-opened on 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2014. Further refurbishment and upgrading work is being undertaken at the Leisure Centre and should be completed by the middle of 2014;

### **Notes from Parish Council Meeting 7<sup>th</sup> January**

#### **2014/5 Precept**

Wrawby Parish Council confirmed that its request for the financial year 2014/5 precept at £10,000 has been accepted by North Lincs Council. This figure is a substantial reduction on recent year's precepts of £13,000, and is testimony to Council's efforts to contain expenditure in these days of austerity. North Lincs Council now operate a grant scheme to benefit the residents of councils that reduce or maintain their precept compared with last year. It is calculated that a grant of £492 is expected for 2014/5 financial year, meaning that the 'actual' precept for Wrawby local residents' purposes is £9,508.

#### **Speed Limits**

Council has received initial proposals that a speed limit of 40mph is being considered to cover the stretch of road from the "30" at the outskirts of Brigg to the "30" restriction entering Wrawby on the A18, at present subject to the 60mph National Speed Limit. When definite details are to hand, residents will be informed.

#### **Road Roundabouts**

Further to recent advices, it is likely that work on the A18 (near Tata Steel, Ashby Ville) roundabout will commence in March. This is likely to be followed later in the year by those to be constructed at Barnetby Top and Humberside Airport crossroads.

#### **Emergency Plan**

Wrawby Parish Council reminds residents that an Emergency Plan is in place to deal with possible future emergencies re weather, accidents etc. In view of ongoing events in other areas, this is considered to be of heightened importance. Council continues its wish to learn of more people in the village who may be able to offer specific skills or assistance with this should the need arise – anyone who can help is asked to contact the Vice-chairman of the Council, Patrick Keilthy on 655360 e-mail [PKeilthy@Talk21.com](mailto:PKeilthy@Talk21.com) or any Councillor (full list in Notice Board at Village Hall). N Lincs Council has arranged a training event for all local councils to meet representatives of the emergency services on 27<sup>th</sup> February 2014. Wrawby Parish Council is to be represented at this event and further details will follow.

Just recently Jeremy Hunt highlighted the treatment of older people in British society as a national disgrace, but by working together on simple solutions – as simple as sparing time for a cup of tea a week – things can change.
