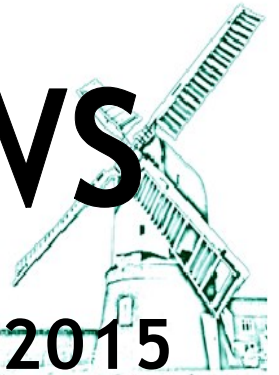

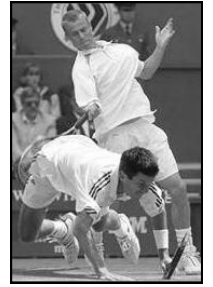

Defibrillator Training



Wrawby residents now have their own defibrillator for anyone to use, if in the unfortunate position of being with someone suffering from a cardiac arrest. The Defibrillator is situated on the wall of Vicarage Motors Garage inside a yellow box with a key pad on the front. When making an emergency 999 call you will be given the number to key in to access the Defibrillator.

As it is really important that our villagers know how to access and use the Defibrillator. Elsham and District LIVES Group are holding a drop in training session on Saturday 6th June between 10.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon in Wrawby Village Hall. There will be demonstrations throughout the morning and an opportunity for you to practice with a training Defibrillator.

Tea, coffee and biscuits will be served.

Please do come along as it may be you who needs to save a life.

Police Report

No recorded crimes in April 2015

Just a quick update to remind everyone to be aware that break in's to sheds, garages and outbuilding are still a concern for us all. Looking at the recorded police logs there are no patterns or specific areas and this is happening throughout North Lincs at various times and days. Please secure the mentioned and please be vigilant, reporting any suspicious activity.

Please be aware that there has been a distraction burglary in the Scunthorpe South Area, where two men have been knocking on doors stating they are from Yorkshire Water and that a sewer pipe in the area has broken and they need to check the water inside properties. The men have ID badges with first names on that they show at the door.

Once inside a property they have distracted the occupant by saying they need to test the water upstairs and down stairs and when they have left, the occupant found the rooms upstairs had been disturbed and cash and credit cards were missing.

Please do not open the door to cold callers, check and verify ID with the company before letting anyone in, do not leave anyone unattended in any part of the property and report anything suspicious to Humberside Police on the 101 number.

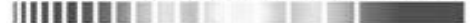

On 31st May, the Church kept Trinity Sunday, which marks the beginning of the Season of Trinity, sometimes called Ordinary Time. The date of Trinity Sunday moves in accordance with the date of Easter, and some years, the Season of Trinity can last up to twenty six weeks.

On Trinity Sunday, the Church reflects upon the Holy Trinity, God who is Father, Son and Holy Spirit, three persons in one God. Over the years, I've tried many ways to help people understand this difficult concept. For example, I've said that just as I am one person, Owain, I have different aspects to my nature – I'm a priest, a parent and a petrol head. I've tried using a jug of water and three glasses, to show that whether the water is in the jug (God) or in the three glasses (Father, Son and Holy Spirit) it's nature remains unchanged. I've tried using Three in One oil – stops rust, lubricates and protects. I've used a Big Mac Meal – one meal made up of burger, fries and a thick shake. There have been other illustrations I've used, but the point is that God is one person who is Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The Holy Trinity is one of the elements of our faith that people struggle the most to comprehend and articulate.

Yet as Christians, we believe strongly in the notion of mystery. God is mystery; the way He works is a mystery; the gift of faith is a mystery. By definition, both mystery and faith do not need explanation, for if we explain these concepts, they are no longer either mystery or faith. I'm finding that the older I get, the more things in life I find difficult to explain, and I just have to accept things as they are, and take them on faith. We cannot answer all of life's questions, some things just are what they are... mysteries. It's a mystery to me why the telephone doesn't ring until I set the alarm and lock my door, or why when I'm late the railway crossing is down, or why when I need to sneeze the tissues are always just out of reach! These things just are; to my mind they are beyond explanation.

Lots of things happen in life, serious things which can cause much pain, and funny little things like those I've mentioned above. We don't know why they happen, and we learn to adapt in order to deal with them. And so I thank God for the gift of faith, that sense deep within ourselves that some things just are, and that I will never understand them, at least in this life. And I pray that I may continue to have a faith, and that the mysteries which life presents to us may be sources of joy, rather than pain.

Holy God, faithful and unchanging: enlarge our minds with the knowledge of your truth, and draw us more deeply into the mystery of your love, that we may truly worship you, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. Amen. (Additional Collect for Trinity Sunday).
