





I was watching the Breakfast news the other day when one of the items was about the abundance of berries and fruit there was about in the countryside this year. Apparently it was due to the long winter, the damp spring and the hot summer making ideal growing conditions. This month of October is the traditional time to celebrate the harvest, our chapel/church celebration is on October 6th. One of the harvest hymns as the words: "All is safely gathered in...", a reminder that the harvest was only the result of a yearlong effort of toil and worry, and now at its end was a chance to celebrate.

For communities like Wrawby which relied heavily on agriculture this was a time to give thanks before the preparations for next years harvest began. Today, of course, we take much of our food for granted, a quick trip to the supermarket and all is gathered in. I wonder how often we think about what has gone in to producing, transporting and presenting that food which makes our regular trips to the supermarket possible.

We're told that a lot of our children and young adults, especially those who live in our towns and cities, have very little idea of where our food comes from. So distant our we now from the actual production of what we eat, that schools are being encouraged to help children grow their own food, in school gardens or at home. Children, once more, are discovering the joy of getting your hands covered in soil and watching something grow that you have planted.

However, many in our world today are not able to produce a harvest. The worlds climate is changing, resources are becoming scarce, an ever growing population is demanding more space to live; meaning less for agriculture. Harvest has never been easy, you can only reap what you have sown, and it is becoming ever more difficult to sow in the first place.

I hope this October you take the opportunity to think about harvest and those from all over the world who have supplied us with the food we eat. We would like to welcome you to share in our Harvest Thanksgiving at church on October 6th at 11am. Nigel


